#### Good Shepherd Lutheran Church Women Piecemakers



It is exciting to report that our recent donation of 60 quilts and 65 school kits has arrived at the Lutheran World Relief Warehouse in Maryland and are currently being processed and prepared for shipment as needed. Depending on current need, supplies are often shipped out immedi-

ately, and nearly all materials will be shipped within six months. We anxiously await learning of their final destination, where they will greatly bless the lives of their recipients!

A recent report from LWR shows that 305,490 quilts were distributed in 12 countries in 2017. Our quilts were all shipped to Georgia, where I am certain they were greatly appreciated during this past extremely cold winter, During the same time frame, LWR shipped 214,490 school kits to children in 17 countries, one of which was Bosnia, where our kits were sent. How thrilling to think of the excitement felt by these children, many of whom will now be able to attend school for the very first time because they have these supplies! Speaking of the school kits, now is an excellent time to be on the lookout for back to school sales on the supplies which will be needed to fill our next batch of school kits!

In the meantime, the Piecemakers are off to a great start on our next contribution to LWR, with 15 quilts already in some stage of production! In addition, we have a graduation quilt for Emily Stieg, who will be off to TCC in the fall, and one quilt in the process of being completed to be auctioned later this year!

We also want to thank you for all the donations of sheets used for backing our quilts. Please note that due to guidelines from LWR, only õgently usedö (no stains, holes or spots) sheets may be accepted.

We have transitioned to our summer schedule of meeting in the quilting room on the first and third Mondays of the month from 10:00 - 1:00. Everyone who is interested in participating in this important ministry is welcome! We look forward to seeing you as your schedule allows!
